9:30 - 11:00 AM – Program

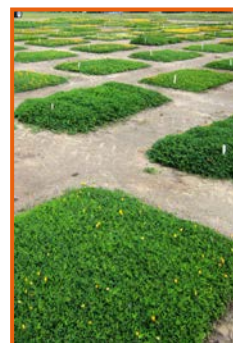
