***New Bermudagrass Pest Found in Florida.*** Bermudagrass stem maggots move into Florida and damage hay fields and pastures by infesting plant tops. Contact your local county extension agent, or extension forage specialists Ann Blount ([paspalum@ufl.edu](mailto:paspalum@ufl.edu)) or Joao Vendramini ([jv@ufl.edu](mailto:jv@ufl.edu)) if you suspect the stem maggot is present in your bermudagrass pasture or hay field.
